Lazy Acres was founded in 1991 in Santa Barbara and environmental action is embedded in its DNA. The local chain takes care to sell products that are sustainably farmed or harvested. Lazy Acres provides customers with products and recipes that promote healthy living and extends this commitment to their facilities by providing electric vehicle charging from EVgo at their stores.

Lazy Acres and EVgo first partnered in 2016, installing their first electric charging station at the Encinitas location. The station consists of two 50 kW fast chargers and one Level 2 (L2) charger. Since then, Lazy Acres has added EVgo fast charging to two other sites – Hermosa Beach and San Diego. Together, the grocers' host 4 DCFC and 5 L2 chargers across the three locations.

Throughout the years, Lazy Acres customers have charged over 1,800,000 minutes over 50,000+ sessions – each session powered by EVgo's 100% renewable energy network. These charging sessions added up to more than 2.3 million zero emissions miles, avoiding 100,000+ gallons of gas from being burned, and preventing over 950 metric tons of greenhouse gas emissions from being released into the atmosphere.
